4. Collisions with other domestic animals or objects; and 5. The potential of a participant to act in a negligent manner that may contribute to injury to the participant or others, such as failing to maintain control over the domestic animal or not acting within such participant's ability.

Acknowledgement of Risk: The undersigned acknowledge(s) that rodeo is a dangerous activity and that participation in rodeo events, rodeo training activities and other rodeo related activities exposes the Participant to a substantial and serious risk of property damage, personal injury and even death.
